

Crazy Stars

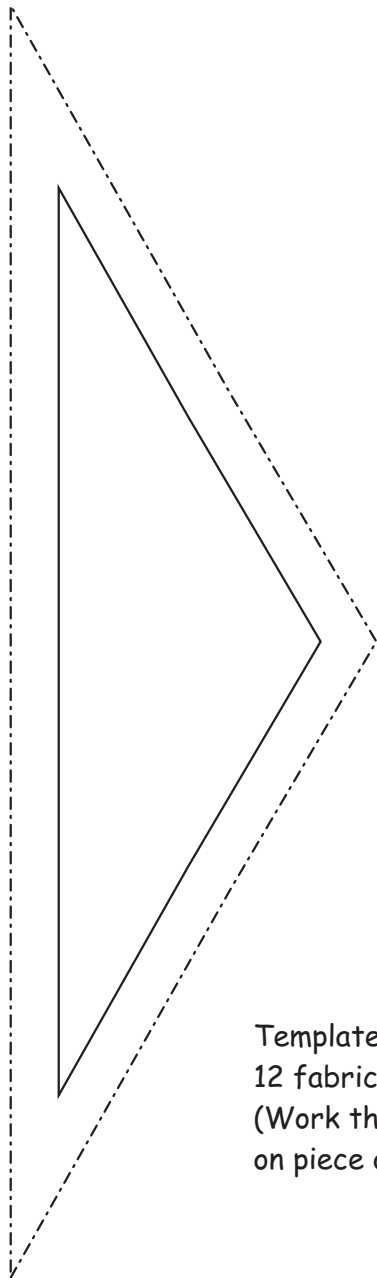
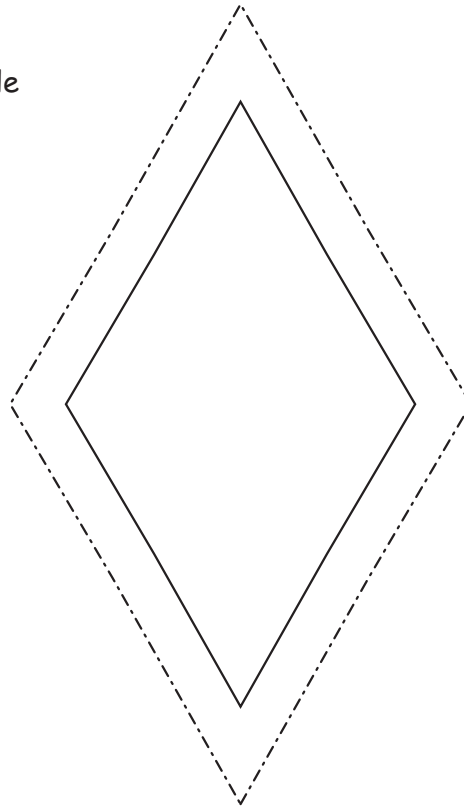

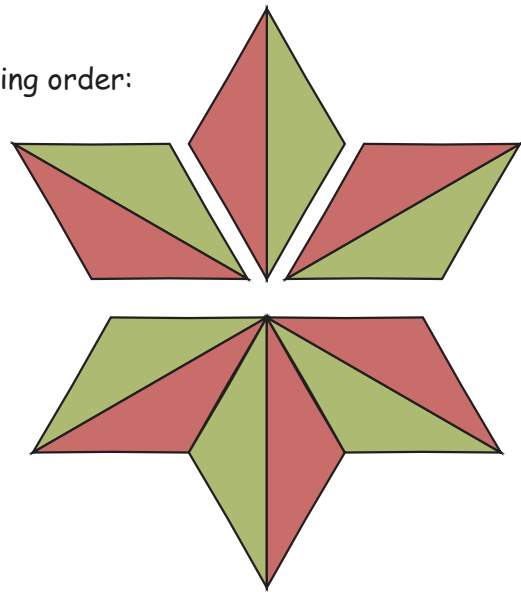
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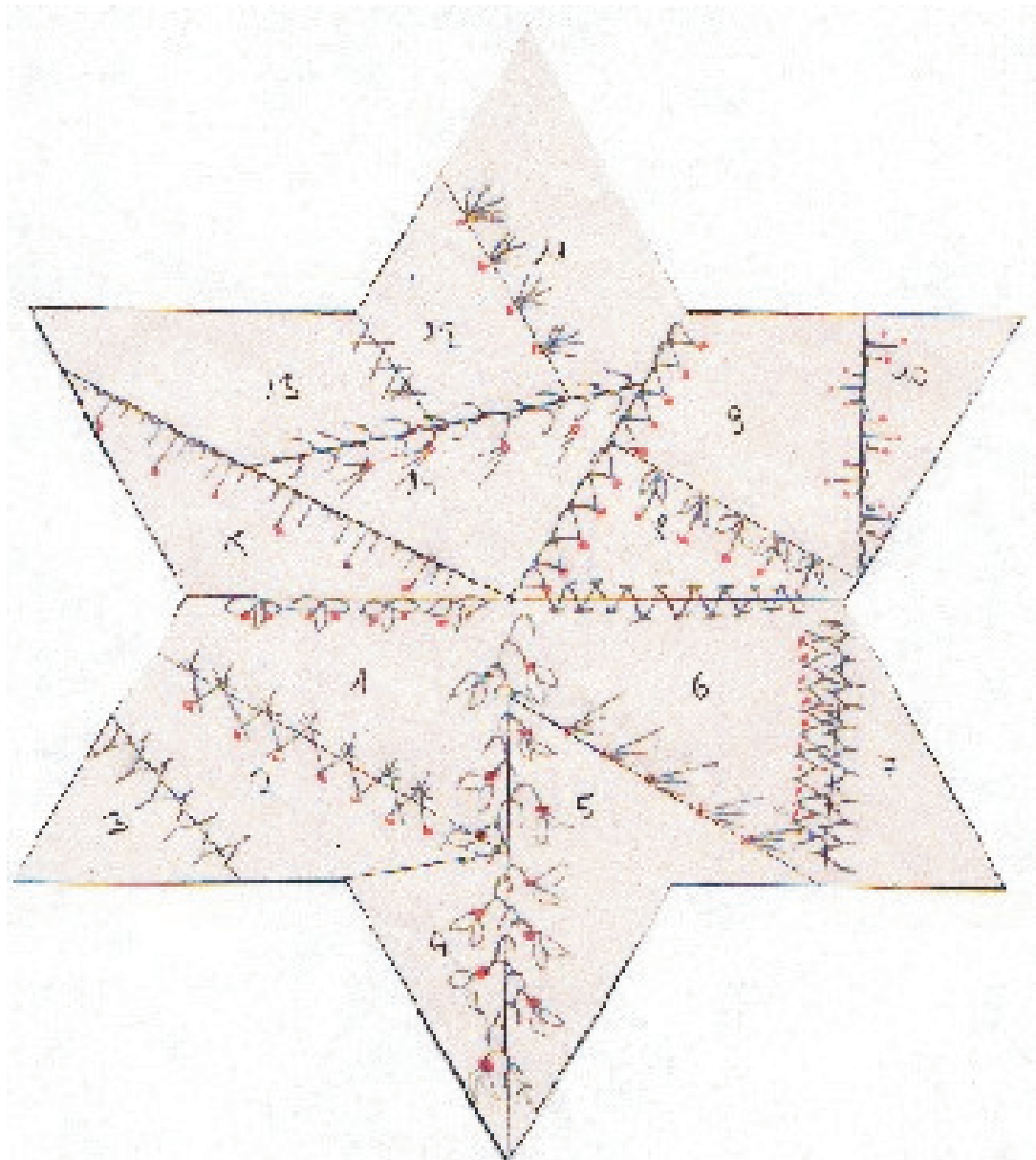
Template for a simple
six-pointed star:



Sewing order:



Template for a bigger 6-pointed star from
12 fabric scraps.
(Work the back identically or simply take
on piece of fabric as backing.)

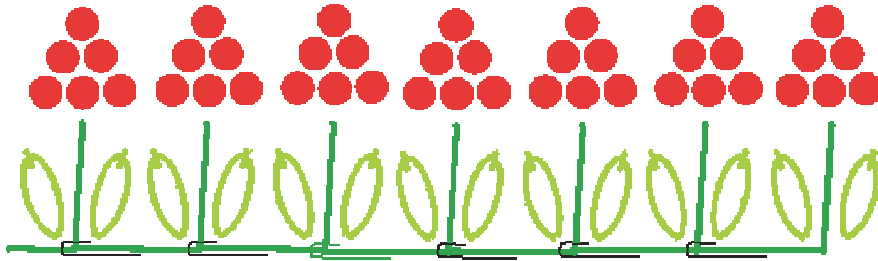


Sew different fabrics in crazy manner together. Cut off the star motiv.

Embroider every seam with crazy stitches.

The red dots in my project are beads.

Some of my best loved crazy embroidery:



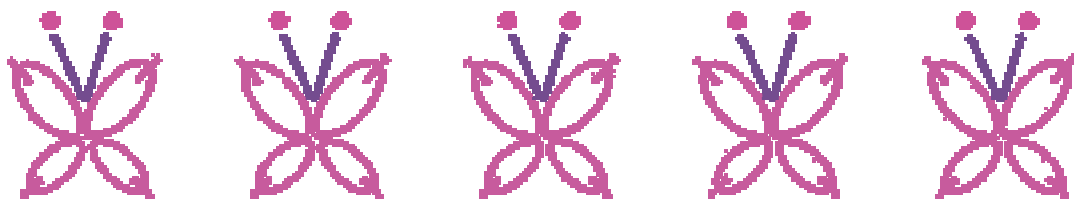
Crazy Quilt Stitch "Flowers"

First work the stems of the flowers. Then the leaves with "Lazy Daisy"-stitches. You can work the blossoms with french knot stitches or sew on beads.



Crazy Quilt Stitch "Bows"

The bows consist of "Lazy Daisy"-Stitches and backstitches as ribbons. The middle is worked with a french knot in a different colour.



Crazy Quilt Stitch "Butterflies"

The wings are made of four "Lazy-Daisy"-Stitches, whereas the upper wingpair should be a little bigger than the lower. The points on the feelers again are made of french knots or glass beads.
